## BIOS

**PROF. DR. EGLĖ BUTKEVIČIENĖ** (*Kaunas University of Technology*) is Professor of Sociology at Kaunas University of Technology, Lithuania, and a member of EUA's Expert Group on Open Science. She is also a founding member of the Citizen Science Association in Lithuania and serves as member of Board of Directors of the European Citizen Science Association.

**ANNE KATHRINE OVERGAARD** (*University of Southern Denmark*) is the Head of Research Support and Innovation at SDU's Health Science Faculty. She has worked as a knowledge broker and project manager in Citizen Science since 2017 and founded the SDU CS Center with Thomas Kaarsted. She is a member of the LIBER CS Working Group.

**THOMAS KAARSTED** (*University of Southern Denmark*) is the Deputy Library Director and Director of the SDU Citizen Science Knowledge Center. He is the manager of several big-scale CS-projects, has worked within the field since 2017 and is member of the LIBER Executive Board.

**DR. ETIENNE SERBE** (*Max Planck Institute for Biological Intelligence*) – Visual Neuroscientist and Senior Scientist at Backyard Brains. Co-Founder of the science collective "hirnkastl" which focuses on Citizen Science and Communication.

**DR. GIEDRĖ GODIENĖ** (*Vilnius University*) – lecturer at the Department of Geography and Landscape Management at Vilnius University, an active expert in public engagement on landscape-related issues, and an enthusiast of informal geographic education.
